The offers shall be delivered in closed and sealed envelopes at the aforementioned address not later than twelve o'clock pm on Sunday 23/9/2018 in exchange of a receipt certifying this delivery; the offers' validity shall not be less than (180) days starting from the tender's closing date conditioned that the offers shall be accompanied by the primary deposit of (1%) of the estimated cost amount. It is worth mentioning that a conference shall be held at the ministry's headquarter at twelve o'clock sharp pm on Monday 17/9/2018 to answer the questions and queries raised by the applicant companies.

The offers shall be opened by the tender opening committee on the same day of the tender's closing date. Any offer that doesn't meet the conditions mentioned in the announcement as well as the tender documents' conditions shall be excluded.
